- Students to arrive from 10:00am. Results will not be available before this time.
- Representatives of local colleges will be in attendance to offer guidance and advice, particularly to those students whose results do not meet the entry criteria for the course of their choice.

- Results will NOT be given out over the phone. If a student is unable to collect their results personally, they can leave a large, stamped, addressed envelope with Mrs Wordsworth who will arrange for them to be posted home.
- Someone may collect the results on their behalf, but they must bring a letter of authorisation signed by the student and bring a form of identification with them.
