



## Home School Agreement

High quality education is only possible with quality supportive partnerships which recognise everyone's responsibilities in ensuring success. As members of the Stockport School community we, the undersigned, accept our respective roles.

\*Please read our Home School Agreement and sign the relevant sections.

### School

- We will ensure that your child is safe while at School and that their physical, emotional and spiritual needs are catered for.
- We will ensure that your child has an appropriate and broad curriculum, personalised to ensure they can make progress and experience success.
- We will treat your child and her family with respect.
- We will regularly mark and assess your child's work, ensuring that they understand the ways in which they can improve their performance, and we will inform you as Parents/Carers of your child's performance and academic needs through annual reports and Parents/Carers Evenings.
- We will set homework and provide support for the completion of homework.
- We will inform Parents/Carers of any problems that your child is experiencing.
- We will inform Parents/Carers of any absence from school.
- We will let Parents/Carers know in good time about school events and give opportunities for them to participate in school life.

### Parent/Carer

- I will ensure that my child attends school punctually every day and will not remove them during term-time for the purpose of a holiday.
- I will ensure that my child is properly equipped and dressed for school each day.
- I will support the Stockport School Behaviour Policy and help to ensure that my child is able to reach the desired standard of behaviour expected at Stockport School.
- I will contact the School if my child is experiencing any problems which could interfere with their happiness and achievement at school.
- I will inform school immediately if my child is absent.
- I will ensure that my child is able to study and complete homework.
- I will attend Parents/Carers Evenings whenever possible.
- I will treat Stockport School and its staff with respect.

### Student

- I will attend school every day unless I am too ill or have an unavoidable appointment which the school has been informed about in advance.
- I will wear Stockport School uniform with pride and remember that I represent Stockport School in the wider community.
- I will complete the homework and classwork that I am set and use the support I am offered so that I can achieve my best.
- I will seek involvement in a wide and varied range of enrichment activities within the School.
- I will respect Stockport School equipment and facilities, and use them sensibly.
- I will show self-respect and respect for others in how I speak and how I act.
- I will accept the professional judgment of all members of staff in the School.
- I will try to make the other students' lives happy, safe and successful by following the School Behaviour Policy.
