

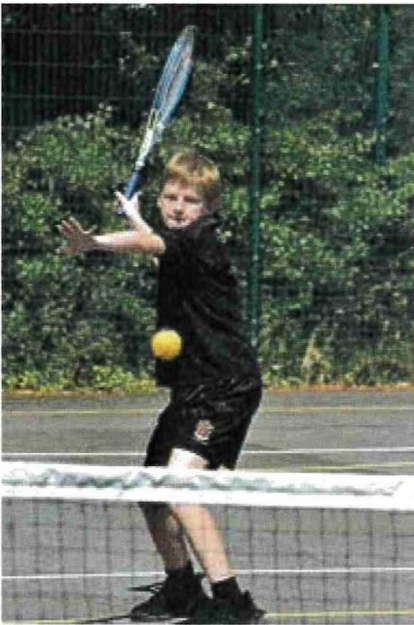

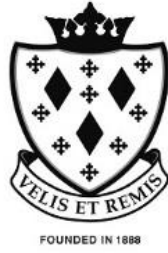

# Stockport School



At Stockport School we are committed to providing additional, enriching opportunities for students away from the classroom.

Enrichment is the opportunity for students to engage in the wider community and teach important life skills. We believe that by encouraging students to participate in extra activities, it can add greater value to their school experience and help them to develop essential skills for life; trying new experiences, building friendships, confidence and resilience and having fun too.

Enrichment and extra-curricular activities at Stockport School take many forms and are included within the structure of the school day as well as before school, after school and during lunchtimes. Within the curriculum timetable there is enrichment during Tutor Time at the start of the day, sports; both practice and fixtures throughout the year and a host of other calendared events and opportunities to participate in and become involved with.

To run alongside the extra-curricular activities, we also run a large number of revision workshops and a Homework support in order to support students with their academic studies.

There are also a wider variety of activities targeted at all year groups which run before school, after school and during lunchtimes.

## Duke of Edinburgh

The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award is a global non-formal education and learning framework which recognizes and celebrates young people's achievements outside of the classroom. The Award allows young people to determine what they are passionate about, regardless of their background, culture or access to resources. By creating opportunities for young people to develop skills, get physically active, give service and experience adventure, the Award can play a critical role in their development.

### **Little Voices Duo Acting Lessons**

The Drama Department hosts 30 minute paired acting lessons for Year 7s and 8s on Wednesdays during lesson times. They encourage and develop core life skills in confidence, vocal projection, handling nerves and anxiety and presentation skills. Students will work towards prestigious L.A.M.D.A. examinations, which are superb to study in their own right and also to support future drama experiences, whilst building their CV and acquiring additional accredited qualifications that can be counted in the UCAS tariff towards university and college.
